**Introduction to fly fishing (4 Hrs)** March 27, 1-5 – April 3, 8-12 – April 17, 1-5 – April 24, 8-12

History of fly fishing, fly rods and lines, leaders/tippets/hooks, simple knots, rigging the fly rod, casting practice, types of flies, and a fly tying demonstration. Movies included.

**Beginning Fly Fishing (8 Hrs)** May 1, 9-5 – May 8, 9-5 – May 15, 9-5

Mechanics of fly rods, fly lines and uses, leaders/tippets/hooks and uses, tying specialized knots, rigging the fly rod, fly fishing accessories, casting mechanics, casting practice, popular flies, and fly tying. Movies included.

**Intermediate Casting (4 Hrs) (approval required)** May 22, 1-5 – May 29, 8-12

Physics of casting, casting faults and fixes, side cast, loop control, false cast, roll cast, shooting line, wind casts, and accuracy casts. Movies included.

**Advanced Casting (4 Hrs) (approval required)** August 7, 1-5 – August 21, 8-12 – August 28, 1-5

Loop control, accuracy casts, single and double hauls, curve casts, distance casting, fishing the clock, shock and drop technique, casting nymphs, streamers, dries, wets in various situations, and review of casting faults and fixes. Movies included.

**Bass Fish Outing (5 Hrs) (approval required)** June 5, 3-8 - June 15, 3-8 – June 26, 3-8 – July 3, 3-8 - July 31, 3-8

We head to a prime bass fishing lake and fish around the lake from the shore. The instructor will demonstrate specific casts and flies to use. You will have time to practice these casts before you go on your own. A valid state fishing license is required for those 17 and older.

**Introduction to Fly Tying (4 Hrs)** September 4, 1-5 – September 11, 8-12 – September 18, 1-5 – September 25, 8-12

Learn about fish, about aquatic/terrestrial insects, history of fly tying, modern flies, tools/materials/equipment for tying flies, and practice tying different kinds of flies. Movies included.

**Family Day Fly Fishing Adventures (4 Hrs) (special requests only)**

All equipment, flies and lake are provided. Everyone 17 years and older must have a Michigan fishing license. Kids must be 10 or older or have instructor approval. Fishing license required 17 or older.
